BATEMANS BAY YOUTH FOUNDATION INC

(BBYF)

Is a registered educational charity. It was started by RC Batemans Bay in 1994 and its mission is to provide a Grant to students who wish to take up a place at University or to commence an Apprenticeship. Because the first year in either case can be expensive, the Grant of \$3,500 provides financial assistance when the student is trying to find his/her way in a new study environment. Those qualified have family hardship in providing the money for the first year. After the first semester, it is assumed the student has found a part-time job.

In 2001, RC Batemans Bay was joined by the Batemans Bay Soldiers Club and the Batemans Bay RSL Sub-Branch, and the three “partners” exercise control through a Management Committee that consists of representatives from all three. The Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer are always Rotarians.

When the Grants Presentation is finished on Thursday evening, Feb 2nd, the Foundation will have given Grants
