His house and his garden were obliterated. With the help of RC Caboolture, he now has a camper trailer to live in, not ideal but better than a tent. The Shade House at the High School was burnt in the fires and the Club has donated new shade cloth and the students will rebuild with some assistance. We still have storage sheds of groceries, drinks and clothes in the Industrial Estate. Care packs are being taken to people in need. The Mogo Recovery will be ongoing as every householder will be surveyed as to their needs and sometimes they just want to talk about their experience. Pallets of masks were airfreighted out from California and these have been distributed along the South Coast. The Annual General Meeting of the Nelligen Recreation Park Ltd was held after the meeting.

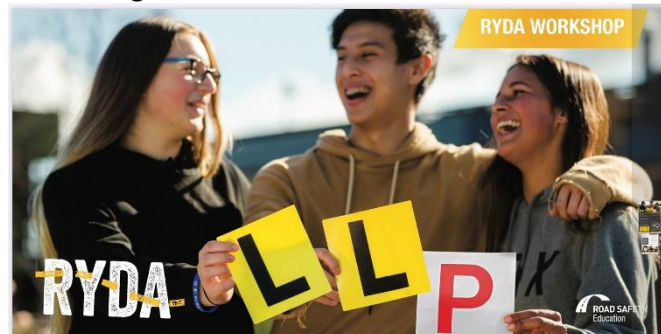
