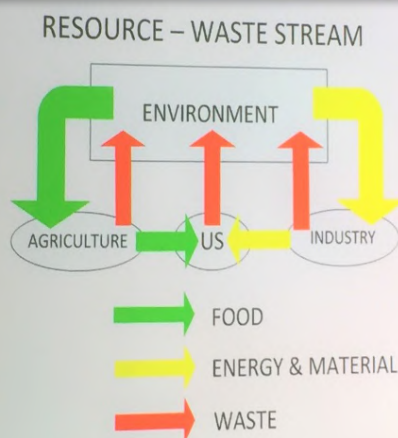

On Thursday evening, Jeff Lean gave us an educated and thought provoking presentation on the economic and social drivers of climate change. Jeff put the focus on **US** to make the change as Governments are not doing enough. It is up to us to reduce resource use by being more frugal. A growth economy is not necessary to our future well being and happiness and is damaging the planet.

He spoke about renewable energy and technology and said they are not sufficient and not possible in the time frame. He spoke about electric cars but to manufacture a lithium battery to run the car has a greater carbon footprint than running a small petrol car for 50,000 kilometres, plus there is in-sufficient lithium and resources to convert totally to electric vehicles.

He urged us to buy what we need not what we want. To buy second-hand or high quality repairable goods. To use cash or debit cards and not be tempted to impulse buy with a credit card.

By reducing our industry and agricultural requirements we will reduce our waste as shown in the above diagram. One thing is certain we all want to leave the planet in good shape for the future generations and we can all make a difference for our grandchildren.

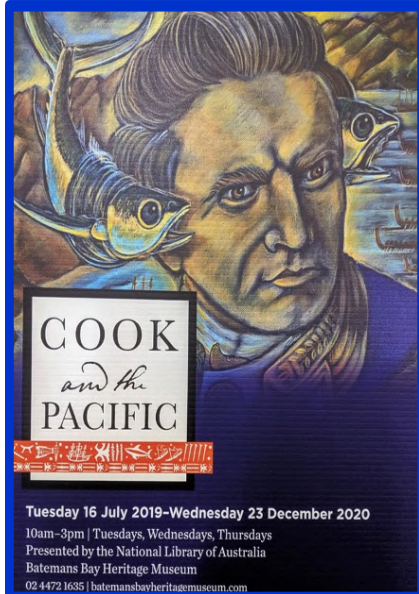
