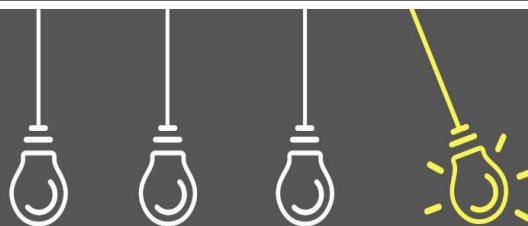

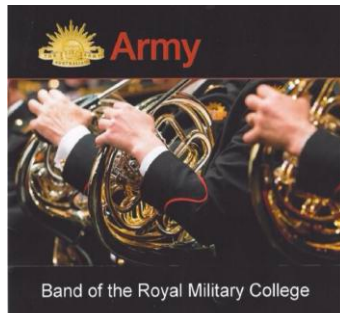

SISTERS HELPEM SISTERS PROJECT UPDATE (from Vere)

Each month a group of ladies gets together to cut, iron, pin and sew. They are making different aspects of reusable sanitary kits which are being sent to midwives in Fiji, Samoa, Kiribati and the Cook Islands. The midwives give the kits, mostly to women in the maternity ward they are caring for. However a recent need was identified in Fiji, where school girls are not participating in activities as they have no sanitary items or underwear and are too poor to buy them. So August will see a change in direction – the women will be



both at the 'sewing day' and work is often taken home. I am very grateful to this group of friends who have embraced this project and contribute in this way. Thanks to the support of our club's Board and a Rotary District Grant of \$2,000 the project will be funded for the next twelve months. Donations of 100% cotton fabric, flannelette fabric, face washers, soap and large full size undies are gratefully received and defray some of the cost.
