## Council on Legislation and Council on Resolutions

You do have a say on how Rotary is governed. We have two processes those being Council on Legislation and Council on Resolutions

### Council on Legislation

Every three years, Rotarians meet at the Council on Legislation to review and vote on proposed changes to the legislation that governs Rotary. They consider enactments, which change Rotary's governing documents, and position statements by the RI Board. Any proposed changes will need to be submitted by **31 December 2017**.

### Council on Resolutions

The Council on Resolutions meets online every year to vote on proposed resolutions, which express opinions and make recommendations to the Board. The closing date for the submitting resolution to the 2018-2019 Council on Resolutions is **30 June 2018**.
