Batemans Bay Rotary, in conjunction with the Moruya and Narooma Rotary Clubs has been running the successful Rotary Youth Driver Awareness (RYDA) program for ten years.

RYDA targets Year 11 students from all High Schools in the Eurobodalla Shire, presenting six 30 minute sessions in a day out of school. The course content represents current best practice in road safety education for Learner Drivers.

The theme of the day is “My Life, My Choices” and covers a broad range of topics including hazard perception, fatigue, stopping distances, vehicle safety and the opportunity to listen to and speak with a crash survivor.

RYDA was held on Monday and Tuesday last week when 228 students attended the course at Moruya Jockey Club from the five high schools in our Shire.

A huge thankyou to the 20 Rotarians from our club who assisted in some way including presenting a session, supervising a group, arranging morning teas and setting up and packing up.

Moruya Rotary Club members made 300 lunches over the two days, the total cost being donated by their club. Narooma Rotary Club paid for transport of the Narooma students plus supervised groups on Tuesday.

Thank you to everyone for making it a great program again. Next year will see our 2000th student and our 11th year in the Eurobodalla.
