- Our Risk Management Plan has been finalised;

- New Club Bannerettes have arrived. Bruce Clarke sourcing dowel and cord;

END POLIO UPDATE

No new cases reported this week



This is a graphic of the Global Switch from Trivalent to Bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine to take place 17 April – 1 May, 2016. The last Type 2 Wild Polio case was recorded in 1999 but 40% of the 2015 Vaccine Induced Polio cases are still from the Type 2 virus in the Trivalent vaccine. The withdrawal of Type 2 from the Oral Vaccine, will prevent an estimated 200 Vaccine Induced Polio cases this coming year. **Could 2015-16 be the year of the final Polio case?**

SHELTERBOX UPDATE:
