The young doctors returned on Thursday evening to receive the second instalment of their Scholarship. Claire Allen and Greg Lee spoke to us about their findings on remote rural health in East Arnhem Land and the Central Desert in NT. Both spoke about the language barrier in these dry Aboriginal communities. Greg found the indigenous peoples very reluctant to engage with the health professionals at the Clinic, there was no preventive medicine in practice and patients were very sick before they sought help. It costs \$25,000 to fly patients to Alice Springs and this flight was running every day!! Hillary Dinning had spent her year here in the Eurobodalla visiting GP Surgeries, Mogo Day Hospital and the two main Hospitals. Being more “hands on”, she had received more experience than she had in Canberra.
