

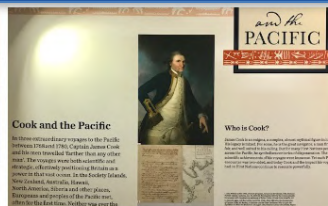

NEW PROJECTS TO HELP THE PHILIPPINES

This year we will be helping **rebuild a preschool** in Barangay Inararo, which was condemned following an earthquake in July 2019. The Intramuros Rotarians, together with their partner club RC Kishiwada-east Japan and RC Canberra are funding the reconstruction of the building and our club's funds will enable the fit out and completion of the building. Barangay Inararo is where our next Global Grant project will provide a water system and ten toilets for people in two villages.



Eye Care Program

Physicians for Peace is an organisation whose CEO is PDG Lyne Abanila, a member of RC Intramuros. PFP manage many health care programs for disadvantaged Filipinos, especially children. With funding, the Eye Care Program employs optometrists who test the eye sight of primary age children, and for those who require eye glasses they are provided. Where a program is conducted, teachers in the schools are taught how to test children for future reference. The picture shows the group of children proudly wearing their eyeglasses they were presented with during the Gray's visit to Manila in November 2016. The banner at the back notes our club's contribution to the program. Bronwyn and Vere will take part in this program when they visit the Philippines in February 2020.
