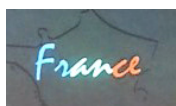

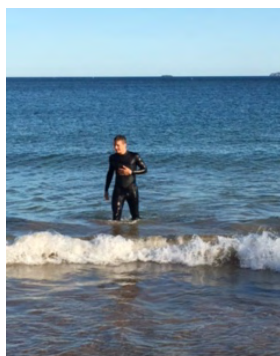
JEFF'S JOTTINGS
