These are the beautiful flowers so kindly sent to me.



Pause in immunization campaigns - The GPEI (Global Polio Eradication Initiative) All countries planning to conduct Poliovirus preventative campaigns are advised to temporarily postpone these campaigns until the second half of 2020. Countries which were planning to conduct Poliovirus outbreak response campaigns are advised to postpone these campaigns until 1 June 2020 and then re-evaluate based on the status of the COVID-19 pandemic. We take this decision with deep regret, knowing more children may be paralysed by Polio as a result. Nonetheless, GPEI believes it is the correct decision, given the imperative to save lives in the current emergency and not contribute to the further spread of COVID-19.
