Judy Rafferty gave a very informative and enlightening talk about asbestos related diseases. As a representative of the Lung Foundation, Judy told us there is a National Strategic Plan for Managing Asbestos with a seven point plan. Australia mined, manufactured and imported asbestos which was not banned until 2003 (it's still used in China and India). Australia has the highest incidence of mesothelioma per capita in the world. You can record your exposure on the Asbestos Safety & Eradication Agency website, and symptoms will be monitored. Judy's advice is to know where asbestos is and treat it with respect.
