PP Pauline Gleeson of Moruya needs no introduction to the Club but she was here on Thursday evening in her role as President of the ASHA Foundation, which was founded in 2007 to help disadvantaged children in Nepal improve their quality of life. Earthquakes in 2015 killed 9000 people and the ASHA Foundation raised over \$100,000 to help rebuild schools.

Their latest project is to provide sanitary pads to ladies in remote villages. Last year over 160 reusable sanitary kits were provided and this year another 200. It is hoped, in the near future, that women's groups in Bhadratar village and surrounding villages will be able to make their own kits through funding from Asha so they can purchase manual sewing machines and materials. In Nepali ASHA means HOPE.
