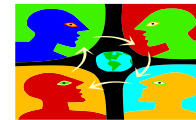

It was pleasing to have the Mayor with us at our last meeting. Clr Brown was a very easy guest for us to host and we were delighted that he could take the time to speak to us about his job and the Shire.

As PP David indicated in his introduction, the Shire Council has very similar goals for their operation which reflect our Four Way Test. The Mayor was able to highlight some aspects of the Councils work and decision making which reflected their goals.

The Mayor highlighted his desire and excitement at having Youth programs within the staffing of the Council which encouraged local youth to study and stay in the area. He also highlighted his desire to move across the Shire, to meet people and to hear from the community of concerns and ideas. Some of these were graciously received by him during question time! He highlighted that since January he has done 95 000km so to meet people. He has enjoyed each opportunity.

Clr Brown hopes to join with us for the Mock Employment Interviews we will have with the Year 10 students at St Peter's on the 24th. The Board will give him Honorary Rotarian status so he can join us so Narooma are not upset!

A very worthwhile meeting and one which informed us on his desires and aspirations as a popularly elected Mayor. He concluded by noting that in NSW we have more women Mayors elected by popular vote (27%) than from the floor of Council Chambers (7%)!

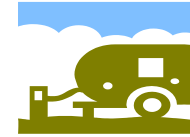
