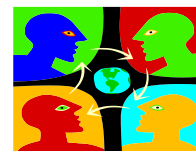

Community Project announced

This year there has been a call for a significant local project for the Club to accept. Ideas were gathered and a recommendation was taken to the Board and accepted. The recommendation had two projects for us to undertake and each was agreed to. One is already started and the other is new but the timing for its implementation is important.

The **first project** is a **Rotary Park Trail** where we link the various park locations, plus possibly some new ones into a trail along which visitors to the area will be able to travel. It would include; Holmes Lookout, Kroner's Park (hopefully our new park), Corrigan's Beach and the new disabled children's park we wish to assist with, Casey's Beach which we originally set up and Observation Point which is a new possibility. Each of these would highlight and show cases our area and Rotary to visitors.

The **second project** is to provide **Swags for the Homeless** of the region. Members have spoken about the need to address Homelessness in the area and this is a way we can afford. This will be timely for the winter of 2015.

The first project we are working on but we need to bring each of the parts together as Councils and National Parks authority make decisions. The second we can prepare for now and have completed quickly.
